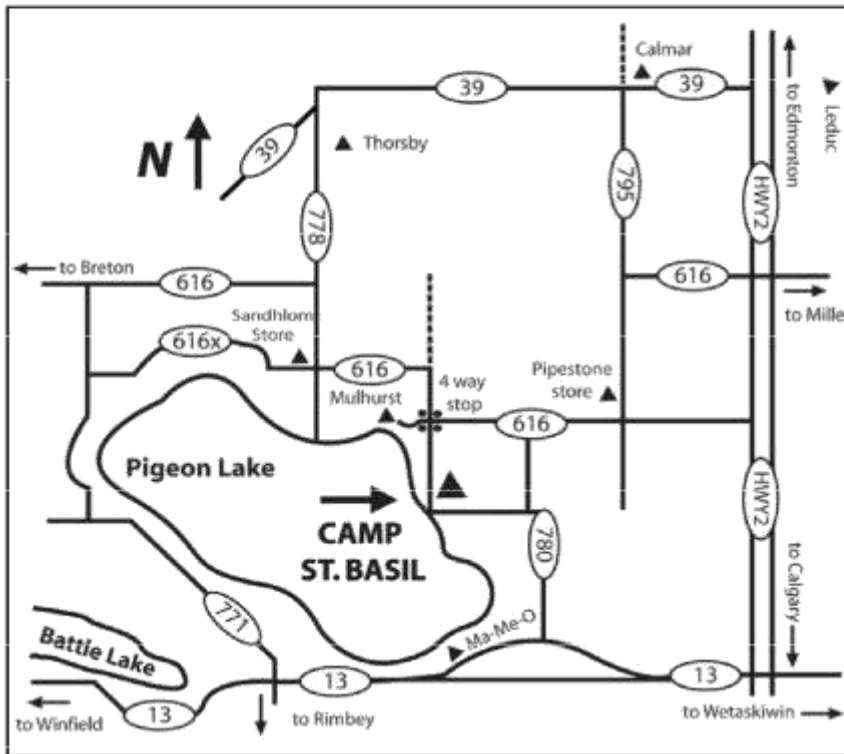

**Check-In:** Sunday, July 6 - 4 PM (Please do not come early)  
Sunday, July 13 - 4 PM

10:00 PM ..... Bedtime

**MEDICATION:** All campers’ medicines must be noted on the registration form and turned over to the Camp Nurse upon check-in. Please specify directions for administration of medication on the registration form (eg. when, how often and how the medication must be taken). If an epi-pen is required, then we suggest that two be brought along.

**HEALTH:** Camp St. Basil is regularly inspected by the County of Westaskiwin health department.

**CANTEEN:** As no money is allowed in camp, a “credit” or Canteen is established for every camper at registration time. This amount, which is not to exceed \$12.00/week [\$2/Canteen Day] allows the camper to purchase snacks/treats each day, Monday to Saturday.

**Phone calls:** will be restricted to after supper.

**Campers should bring:** Bedding or sleeping bag, pillow, 2 towels, toiletries, 2 pairs of shoes (runners and sandals), watershoes, clothing for at least 7 days (indoor & recreational, for fair or rainy weather), modest 1 piece bathing suit, hat, sunglasses, insect repellent, sun screen, pens & pencils, note-book, and reading material. **LABEL EVERYTHING.**

**Campers SHOULD NOT bring:** ipods, Cell phones, radios, CD/DVD Players or anything electronic. **iPODS and CELLPHONES WILL BE CONFISCATED and held until the end of camp.** Other items not to bring: matches, lighters, knives, valuables or money. Unapproved items are subject to confiscation until the end of camp. **The camp will not be responsible for any lost items.**
